The Fiesta Story

60 years of Fiesta fun!

Our Fiesta has always been the pride and joy of the OLA community, and rightly so. It has the perfect combination of multi-cultural and multi-generational celebration, family values, community participation, quality entertainment, and just plain fun!

It's thrilling to know that it has always been like this. The Fiesta has roots in a history much older than its 60 years. The original Catholic community in Claremont sponsored home-grown celebrations called *jamaicas* in the 1930's and 1940's with music, dancing, games, and great food. This is how they raised funds to build Sacred Heart Chapel and maintain it.

In 1947, the same year Our Lady of the Assumption Parish was formally organized, the first "Fiesta" took this successful formula and combined it with the raffle of a Plymouth sedan. An impressive \$3,500 was raised for the construction of our present-day church.

Both Spanish-and English-speaking parishioners enjoyed great food, music, dancing, games, and carnival rides on a site next to the rectory on Foothill Boulevard just west of Yale Avenue. In a tradition that continues to this day, the first Fiestas brought people together to enjoy the best of our diverse cultures and celebrate life.
